- Reduce falling material hazards
- Keep conveyor areas cleaner
- Avoid damage to conveyor components
- Abrasion & weather resistant

Material .....	Styrene Butadiene Rubber (SBR)
Hardness .....	55-60 (Shore A)
Tensile Strength .....	1000psi
Elongation .....	300%

### Why you should never use old belts as skirtboard

With a 60 durometer rating skirtboard rubber is intentionally 'softer' than the conveyor belt it is in contact with.

Being softer the skirtboard will not wear the conveyor's top cover. Using old cut-up conveyor belt as skirtboard will place two similarly hard products in contact with one another, significantly raising the risk of damage to the conveyor belt.
