

Installation Guide for FRAMELESS INLET DRAIN FILTER



1. Remove drain grate and clean any sediment or debris from grate lip and ground surface.



NOTE: Write the installation date on the product label.

2. Place Drain Filter over opening. Filter fabric should overlap drain by at least 3" on all sides.



NOTE: Optional retainer rods for increased strength and capacity are available. Search for DFRODS at spilltech.com

3. Tape down all corners to temporarily hold Drain Filter in place.



4. Replace grate, keeping it level as you lower evenly onto Drain Filter.



5. Remove tape and trim excess fabric, keeping roughly 3" of material on all sides.



TIP: To empty or change out the filter, remove the grate and filter at the same time by feeding grate hook through the hi-viz strap before lifting.

INSPECTION & MAINTENANCE

- Inspect monthly or after every ½" rainfall event
- Use a shovel or broom to remove accumulated sediment from around the edge of drain
- Replace product seasonally; slow filtration or moderate amounts of sediment and floatables in the filter pocket may indicate that the product is not filtering at maximum efficiency
- Dispose of the product in compliance with local, state and federal regulations
